Where is the Leadership Boot Camp Held?

The Leadership Boot Camp will take place on trtownsend.com website in the Leader's Hall as well as the Power15 Conference line (712-432-0075 access code 487581#). **There is no location or travel required** to participate in the Boot Camp. Only a few hours per week. People all over the world can participate in this Boot Camp.

What do I need to do to apply or get started?

If you are reading this, you are halfway there. By attending the orientation at **8:30 p.m.** on Monday, February 29, 2016. This will allow you an opportunity to get an overview of the Boot Camp and ask questions.

What do I do after completing the registration form? Am I automatically in?

After you complete the registration form, you will receive information within 48 hours concerning your next steps. **There is a CUT-OFF.** We do not desire a large class; therefore, we are accepting applicants based upon those who are truly ready for this intensive. That decision will be based upon the responses in your registration submission.

Why is the orientation time at 8:30 p.m.?

Most of the young adults, whose lives we reach, are in agreement that late hours work best with their school and work schedules. Keep in mind, the orientation is a call (712-432-0075 access code 487581#). Individuals will "call in" to the conference line above. **You are listening on the phone,** you are not at a location.

Is there an attendance requirement? What do I do if I can't make a session?

Your success is based upon your attendance; however, you have flexibility to arrange your schedule within the guidelines of the Leadership Boot Camp. What are some of the requirements for me being a part of the Boot Camp?

- Our **youngest leader** must be “at least” 16 years of age. For ages 16 & up
- acknowledge that you possess leadership potential.

What are some of the requirements for me being a part of the Boot Camp (continued—see previous responses)?

- Meet every Monday on the conference line during the 4-week intensive (8:00 p.m. - 8:15 p.m. CST-(712-432-0075 access code 487581#).
- Participate in Leaders Hall (Located on trtownsend.com website). Must have the access code in order to participate.
- Meet with the coach once a week (you schedule a time).
- Be **WILLING TO GROW**...this includes receiving some feedback, asking questions, and –doing the work needed to obtain outcomes—
- Participate in group discussion (once each week)

I want to be a part, but I am nervous because I don't fully understand how this will work. What can I do?

Starting new things can be intimidating or exciting. Your view is based upon your past experiences. Treat this decision as an opportunity that will open **NEW** doors to your life. It's ok to be nervous, but it's not ok to allow that nervousness to stop you. You can always ask questions (they are encouraged). You will understand the Boot Camp more clearly once you engage and become involved. It will be **ONE** of the greatest decisions you make this year.
